- I. Regular meeting time confirmed
 - A. 2nd Wednesday of the month at 12-130pm
- II. SUD survey progress
 - A. Survey's finalized (thanks small group for your help!)
 - B. On track to send out in next couple weeks; there may be two/multiple waves of distribution
 - C. Not including NRTs as an incentive to complete the survey at this time, but are exploring logistics to distribute at some point in this project
- III. Population-level data
 - A. Population-level data can allow us to make population-level estimates which we can then use to tell us important things about our population's health
 - B. Exploring multiple population-level data sources for this project: APAC, BRFSS, SHS, Quitline dashboards, NSDUH (see slides for details)

- 1. Remember that we need to be looking at generational data whenever possible. Each generation has different mental health issues, uses the system differently, and has different treatment approaches.
 - a) It can be hard to get disaggregated data by age, race, lgtbq, ability, etc. due to small numbers, but we need to find ways to understand differences
- 2. There are a ton of NSDUH indicators. What would be most important for this project?
 - a) Tobacco use vs. smoking: consider what the populations we are looking at are using
 - b) Look at all mental illness, but prioritize serious mental illness if we need to limit it due high rates of use with SMI
 - c) What about anxiety? Hunch that there are very high rates of smoking/tobacco use
