Notes (high-level summary):

- Revision of assessment questions
Background: In summer 2021 the panel developed a “brainstormed” list of questions for the assessment. During this meeting the panel reviewed the questions. Beck asked the group to prioritize questions that were most important at this stage of the project. Group discussion about the questions surfaces the following themes:
 - Important to address provider culture and medical systems
 - Consider youth and disabled populations
 - Peer recovery model in BH systems and among workforce
 - Aim to have a total of 3-5 assessment questions (this was Beck/Rede’s target number)
- Beck shared reasons for prioritization and ways to think about prioritization
 - Limited Time, Capacity and Funding
 - What would lead to the biggest impact in the BH system for tobacco recovery?
 - Assess the system and develop a baseline
 - Look to billing and clarity of funding

- The panel did not prioritize assessment questions citing the importance of all questions but themes arose: baseline assessment, culture shift, provider role, billing
