- I. New Members

  - A. State Interviews, culturally specific analysis, SAMSA database, APAC, continue research.

  - B. Feedback/comment:
    - 1. Who are we trying to reach, is there a number of people we want to reach per organization?

- 2. Peers, mentors and case managers would be great to distribute these surveys. Someone with client rapport.
- 3. The possibility of multiple surveys to address specific questions for administrators (policy related) and questions for other roles at facilities.
- 4. There appears to be issues obtaining contact information for BH facilities.
- 5. Including group homes in the list too, because some have outpatient services.
- 6. Rede will explore ways to do a modular survey where different segments would go to different entities within a site.
- 7. Concern around dissemination.
- V. Information clarified by Rede
  - A. This survey is for outpatient facilities.
- VI. Incentives
  - A. Options: Gift Card, No incentive, NRT, training on how to treat nicotine dependence.
  - B. Provide participants with options within the survey (menu of incentives).
  - C. Feedback on options: NRT (peers would be excited to hand it out), referral to Oregon quitline to encourage them to continue getting NRT, Giving people an option is great!
- VII. Small Group
  - A. Help Rede with survey language, administer it in modules, Figuring out audiences, etc.
  - B. Volunteers: Sari, Thais, Nadia, Reina, David, Jim.
