

The Oregon Nicotine Treatment and Recovery (NiTR) in Behavioral Health Expert Panel, organized and funded by the OHA department of Health Prevention and Chronic Disease Prevention and managed by the Rede Group,+ is open for recruitment.

This workgroup is tasked with assessing gaps in commercial tobacco/nicotine dependence treatment for behavioral health populations and making recommendations for improvements. This workgroup needs to include diverse voices to make sure recommendations are relevant for a wide range of people interacting with the behavioral health system.

The Expert Panel workgroup is interested in new members who have some intersectionality of experience (especially being tobacco users or former users themselves). Other representation needed on the Expert Panel is:

- Professionals who work in childcare in inpatient Substance Use Disorder facilities;
- Community Based Organizations receiving Ballot Measure 108 funding;
- Peer Support Specialists working in behavioral health;
- Behavioral Health agencies/professionals from Coordinated Care Organizations;
- Agencies facilitating youth collaboratives (adolescent/young adult age range) regarding tobacco prevention, youth with experience in behavioral health, such as behavioral health therapy (inpatient or outpatient), and/or youth with experience with recovery from commercial tobacco.
