
MCHHS Service Equity Assessment Individuals in Service Survey - Analysis


The Individuals in Service survey was implemented to gather feedback from the people MCHHS serves to help understand strengths and challenges related to diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Demographics:



Citizenship status




Annual Household Income






How MCHHS could do a better job of serving diverse individuals and communities





Answers from BIPOC and Latinx Respondents Only (n=22)




Answers from White Respondents Only (n=59)





How MCHHS can do a better job of serving diverse individuals and communities, by race of respondent




Data by Disability of Respondents (n=16)
