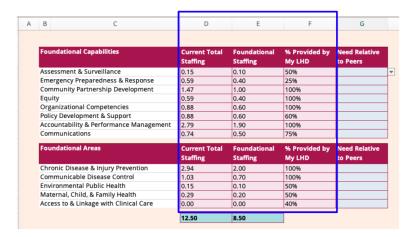
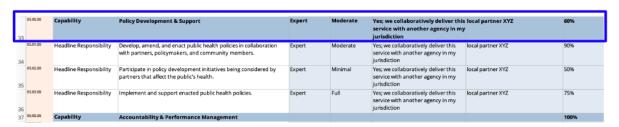
Worksheet .08 PHWF Calculator

The first table on Worksheet .08 PHWF Calculator starts at row 15

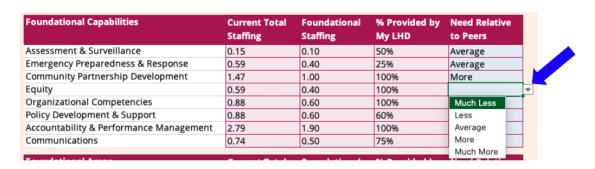
1. In this table, the numbers from column D and E are **auto filled** from Worksheet .06 Current Spending. Column D is the total FTE (FPHS and CSS) and E is the FTE allocated toward just FPHS



2. Column F is **auto filled** from Worksheet .07 Self-Assessment, from the percentages you listed at the **Capability level**



3. Colum G: Need Relative to Peers, this column is **not** auto filled, however **if you don't do anything, it will default to average in the PHWF Calculator**. See the Q&A for guidance related to this.



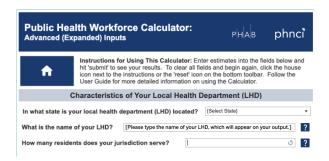

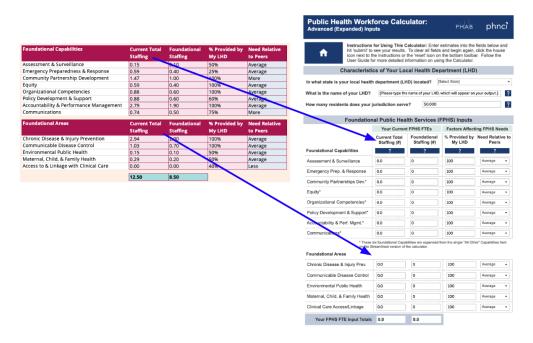
1. Select "Advanced Calculator (Expanded)"



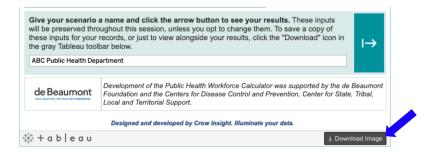
2. Complete the top section of information: The state, name of your LHD, # of jurisdiction residents



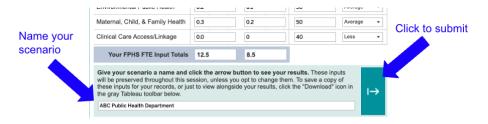
3. Fill in the PHWF Calculator table (seen on the right) so that it matches your first table on Worksheet .08 (that starts at row 15) - complete all 4 columns of the PHWF Calculator: Current Total Staffing, Foundational Staffing, % Provided by My LHD, and Need Relative to Peers



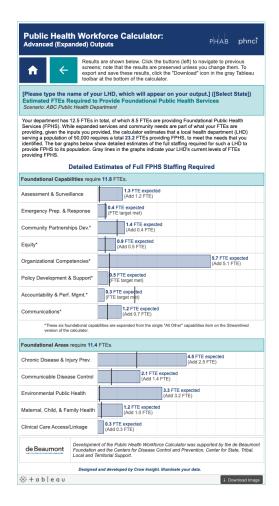
4. When you've completed inputting all the information, consider downloading the image to save (on your computer) the table of everything you inputted



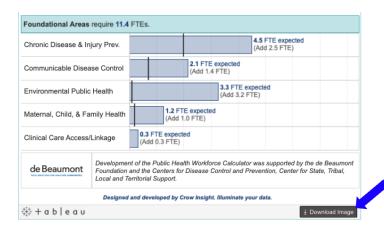
5. Name your scenario and click submit



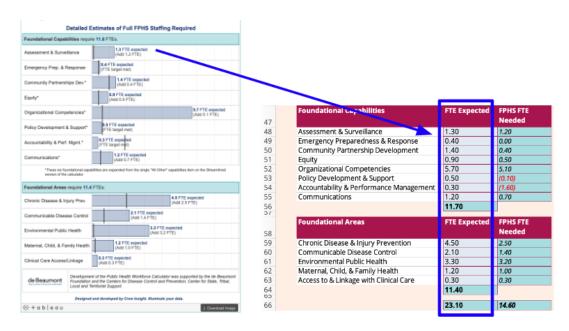
6. The results/outputs will look like this → *the PHNCI calculator will round numbers



7. Click the Download button at the bottom of the results/outputs table. This will give you a separate document that you will use to fill out the bottom tables of Worksheet .08 PHWF Calculator



8. Using the "FTE Expected" results from the PHWF Calculator, complete column D of the bottom two tables of Worksheet .08 PHWF Calculator



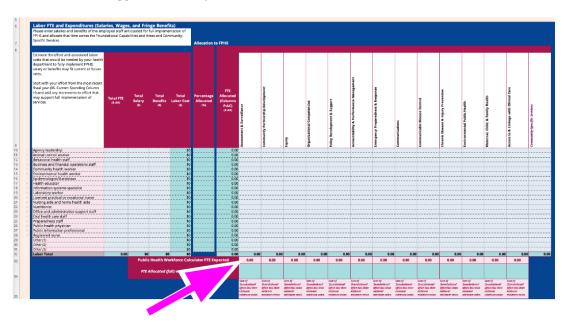

Worksheet .09 Full Implementation

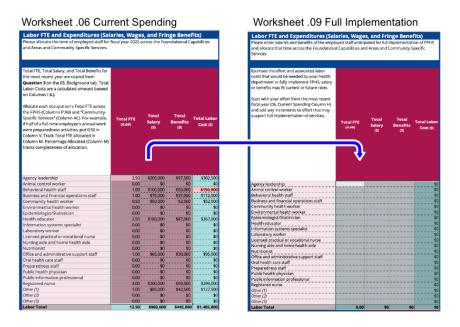
This worksheet asks that you estimate what resources may be necessary to fully implement the FPHS, imagine how you would fully implement FPHS (and CSS) for your jurisdiction if there were no barriers. So, this Worksheet is based off of what already exists (such as what you have listed in Worksheet .06 Current Spending, see step 2 below) *PLUS* what else you may need.

The first section is where you will estimate the allocation of FTE
*row 33 is the suggested FTE Expected from the PHWF calculator, it will auto-fill from Worksheet .08



This FTE Expected is a recommendation. Utilize your knowledge of your jurisdiction, public health expertise, AND the PHWF Calculator results to create your estimations

2. To help develop a scenario of how you would fully implement the FPHS, copy columns H, I, and J from Worksheet .06 Current Spending and paste it to columns H, I, and J in Worksheet .09 Full Implementation. Utilizing your knowledge of your jurisdiction, public health expertise, AND the PHWF Calculator suggestions, make adjustments to staffing needs (columns H, I, J) or Worksheet .09



- 3. Allocate needed FTE across the FPHS and CSS
- 4. Complete the sections Direct Contracts, Other Operating Expenditures, Pass-throughs and Transfers, and Capital Expenditures

*Increases and decreases in staffing in order to fully implement the FPHS will result in necessary changes to these other categories
