#### What are the Foundational Public Health Services?


The foundational responsibilities of governmental public health defined by a minimum set of capabilities and areas that must be available in every community in order to provide fair opportunities for all to be healthy

#### What is the FPHS FCC Assessment?

The Assessment is an Excel-based tool used to understand current costs, expertise, and capacity that Wisconsin can then use to:

- Assess systemwide spending and capacity towards the FPHS
- Determine the needed investments to fully implement the FPHS to strengthen the programs necessary to meet the needs of your jurisdiction
- Identify the resources to transform governmental public health systems and then organize partnerships and advocate legislation for those resources


