Collab Space

- The <u>Collab Space</u> online is the main resource center for you, there you can find the Instructional Guide and Operational Definitions under the section <u>Assessment Tool &</u> <u>Resources</u> - You'll want to read those before and during the process, oftentimes the answers to your questions are in those documents.
- <u>Q&A</u> this is a live document that gets updated each week with questions you and your peers have asked and their answers. This is also a good place to look for quick answers.

Walk-through & Training Meetings

- For 5 weeks, Rede Group will hold 4 one-hour meetings to walk through one of the Worksheets of the Assessment:
 - Week 1: week of June 26th Worksheet .04 FY 2022 Staff
 - Week 2: week of July 3rd Worksheet .05 Background
 - Week 3: week of July 10th Worksheet .06 Current Spending
 - Week 4: week of July 17th Worksheet .07 Self-Assessment
 - Week 5: week of July 24th Worksheet .09 Full Implementation
- Meeting times and dates with links to register will be sent to you by email and will get updated on the Collab Space as they get scheduled.
- Attendance of each meeting will be limited to 12 Health Departments and will be a registration, first come first served basis.
 - Please only register once for your health department, do not register multiple individuals.
 Once registered, you can have multiple people from your health department attend.
 - \circ \quad *Rede will increase these limits in response to increased requests
- One meeting per week will be recorded and that recording will be provided to everyone via the Collab Space.

1:1′s

- These are 30 minute meetings between your agency and Rede Group to go over your specific questions and issues.
 - If your agency needs a greater amount of time we can discuss it and be flexible
- 1:1s are by request and scheduled in the order they are requested. The form to request a 1:1 is on the Collab Space on the TA and Presentations section.
 - There is no limit to the number of 1:1s you can have, however, keep in mind that if there is a high volume of requests that may create scheduling limitations on Rede's end
- Rede requests that you and your team come prepared with specific questions you have from attempting to complete the parts of the Assessment you are requesting support for.
