



What is a purpose statement and how will it be used?

This purpose statement will inform how OHA and funded partners:

- work together and with community to advance community health priorities
- select grant program priorities and make program decisions
- measure success and progress for this project

Purpose statement and theory of change

Complementary pieces that tell the story of the program

Purpose statement should communicate:

- What we are trying to achieve
- Why it matters

Logic model or theory of change should communicate:

 How we will achieve the stated purpose
